About the Speaker

Dr. Ram Singh is currently a Professor at the Delhi School of Economics (since 2005). Prior to that he has held academic positions at Jawaharlal Nehru University (2003-2005). He has also held several visiting positions at Brown University, London School of Economics, University of Hamburg and K University – Leuven. He holds a PhD. in Economics from Jawaharlal Nehru University and did Post-doctoral research at Harvard University. He has received several prestigious fellowships in economics like the Commonwealth fellowship, Erasmus Mundus Scholarship, Ronald Coase fellowship to name a few. He is the Associate Editor of the *Indian Economic Review* and also the treasurer for the Center for Development Economics. He had also been a member of the National Transport Development Policy Committee Working Group on Railways.

Prof. Singh's area of research is in Microeconomic theory with special interest in Law and Economics, Contract theory, Public-Private partnerships and Property rights. He is well known in his field both within India and internationally. His research in economic analysis of law and its implications are published in top journals in the field, which includes *International Review of Law and Economics*, *American Law and Economics Review*, *European Journal of Law and Economics* and *Review of Law and Economics*. Through his research and many newspaper articles and opinions, Prof. Singh has made an impression in the policy domain particularly in areas of land acquisition and property rights, public-private partnerships and contract laws in various domain.
